# Faith Formation Scholarship Program & Confirmation Service Hours 2011/2012

Service Hours Required for Confirmation: Confirmation I or 9th Grade - 15 Hours  
Confirmation II or 10th Grade - 30 Hours

The following are ways to earn the 500 points which are needed to win a Faith formation Scholarship of \$500 at the end of your senior year.

YOU MUST REPORT THE FOLLOWING YOURSELF ON THE GREEN SHEETS FROM THE OFFICE OR ON-LINE AT [saintmonicaparish.com](http://saintmonicaparish.com) AND TURN THEM IN OR EMAIL IT.

- Any Corporal Work of Mercy where you are serving others (this does NOT include working in concession stands or refereeing games) = 1 point for each hour of service.
- Any service to St. Monica: cleaning, weeding, mowing, \*altar serving in 9th/10th grades, nursery work, being in the choir, lecturing, being an usher/greeter, being an RE aide during the school year, VBS or Summer RE \* = 1 point for each hour of time served.
- Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament = 1 point for each hour in prayer.
- Attendance at Our Lady of Guadalupe Summer Camp = 40 points.
- Daily Mass = 1 pt.
- Weekend Mass Attendance taken via tithing envelope.\*\*  
(No points given for this but attendance is REQUIRED)

## THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES WILL BE REPORTED BY THE SUPERVISING ADULTS:

- Confession = 10 pts. (sign-in at back of church) - or report other times gone yourself
- Attendance at RE classes = 1 point for each class attended.
- Attendance at Summer RE (or as an aide) = 40 points.
- Attendance at Youth Group = 1 point for each time you attend.
- Attendance at Work Camp = 50 points
- Attendance at Retreats like NET or Confirmation Retreat = 20 points
- Attendance at any Catholic Conferences like NCYC, Region X, = 40, 30 or 20 points depending on where it is and the length of the event.
- Any Youth and Family Night - 10 points (any parent who attends with you will get you 5 points each - This is also true for Confirmation I and II Parent Meetings).

If a student attended everything possible for four years, he/she would accumulate over 1,264 hours. To be on track, a student needs to gain 125 points a year toward the 500 total. At least 100 of these points MUST BE EARNED DURING YOUR SENIOR YEAR AND 80 OF THESE POINTS MUST BE EARNED AT ST. MONICA.

TO QUALIFY FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP, YOU MUST STAY ACTIVELY LEARNING YOUR FAITH IN EITHER CATHOLIC SCHOOL, JUNIOR/SENIOR R.E. OR YOUTH GROUP DURING YOUR JUNIOR AND SENIOR YEARS. ONE MUST BE A MEMBER AT ST. MONICA AND ATTEND MASS REGULARLY HERE AT ST. MONICA.

\*Altar serving is not part of this program in the junior and senior years. Those who serve these years are eligible for Father Ray's \$500 scholarship.

\*\*Envelopes, dropped in the collection each week is how we keep track of attendance. Envelopes may be obtained in the office now, and in December, 2011, the envelopes for the next year will be distributed in RE Classes.

In February or March of one's senior year, anyone desiring a scholarship should make an appointment with Katie Gordy to go over accumulated points. Students will be asked to write a 500 word reflection on what his/her involvement at St. Monica's has meant to them. This essay is required to obtain the scholarship, and should be brought to the appointment with Katie.
