Sacred Wash Instructions

Please pick up the Sacred Wash after the 1pm Sunday Mass. It should be on the shelf outside the Sacristy. They need to be returned by Friday of the same week. Please make sure they are stain-free and ironed totally dry.

- **Inspect** linens immediately.
- **Sort** out any linens that have stains.
- **Treat** stains with a stain remover and soak in cold water in a small wash pan. Dispose of “soak” water in grass or houseplants.
- **Run** your washing machine with an empty load to clean it thoroughly before washing the Sacred Wash.
- **Wash** linens by hand or in washer with regular soap--liquid or powder. Liquid bleach should be used. Wash, rinse and spin-dry.
- **Iron** as soon as possible. Linens are 100% cotton and are best ironed when damp. They will iron very crisp without spray starch if ironed damp. We want them to be as absorbent as possible; therefore, starch is not recommended.

Purificators are rectangular. Press, fold in thirds lengthwise; then in half. Press. *Fold in thirds lengthwise; then in half.*

Corporals are square. Press. With “wrong” side “down” closest to Altar then fold 1/3 down from top, 1/3 up from bottom, 1/3 from the left and 1/3 from the right forming a square. Cross should be in lower bottom when unfolded.

If you are unable to take the Sacred Wash on your assigned week, please contact another Sacred Wash minister to trade weeks. If you are unable to find a substitute, please contact me.
